I intend to fulfill all necessary [Harvard College requirements](#). I understand that all candidates for the Bachelor of Arts or the Bachelor of Science degree must pass 128 credits (the equivalent of thirty-two 4 credit courses) and receive letter grades of C– or higher in at least 84 credits of them (at least 96 credits to be eligible for a degree with honors). I understand that the conferral of the concurrent master’s degree is conditional upon completion of all Harvard College requirements and both degrees must be completed by the end of eight terms of residency.

Master’s Degree Planning

I have used the Concurrent Master’s Planning Worksheet (on the [OUE website](#)) to develop a detailed plan to fulfill the master’s degree requirements for my program of interest. I also understand these courses may change based on course availability.
